KCHR to hold its regular monthly meeting in Bowling Green, Kentucky

Louisville – The Kentucky Commission on Human Rights (Commission) Board of Commissioners will hold its regular monthly meeting in Bowling Green on **Thursday, April 16, 2026**. The meeting will take place at the Bowling Green Neighborhood and Community Center, Conference Room, located at 707 East Main Avenue, Bowling Green, Kentucky 42101, at 12:00 PM (Central Time). The meeting is open to the public. The Commission is holding this meeting in Bowling Green to provide local residents with an opportunity to attend and engage with the Commission.

Immediately following the board meeting, a one-hour community outreach session will be held at the same location. This interactive session will give attendees the opportunity to learn about the Kentucky Civil Rights Act and the complaint process at KCHR. Commissioner and Commission managers will also be available to answer questions.

The Commission is the state government agency charged with enforcing the Kentucky Civil Rights Act. The Commission receives, investigates, and rules on jurisdictional complaints of discrimination. The Act prohibits discrimination in public accommodations, employment, housing, and financial transactions based on race, color, religion, national origin, disability, and sex. Additional protections include familial status in housing; age (40 and over) and pregnancy in employment; and tobacco-smoking status in employment.
