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KCHR to hold its regular monthly meeting in Ashland, Kentucky

Louisville – The Kentucky Commission on Human Rights (Commission) Board of Commissioners will hold its regular monthly meeting in Ashland on **Thursday, September 17, 2026**. The meeting will take place at the Ashland Transportation Center (Ashland Bus Depot), located at 99 15th St, Ashland, KY 41101, starting at 9:00 A.M. The meeting is open to the public.

The Commission is holding this meeting in Ashland to provide local residents with an opportunity to attend and engage with the Commission. Anyone may address the Commission during the public comment session.

The Commission is the state government agency charged with enforcing the Kentucky Civil Rights Act. The Commission receives, investigates, and rules on jurisdictional complaints of discrimination. The Act prohibits discrimination in public accommodations, employment, housing, and financial transactions based on race, color, religion, national origin, disability, and sex. Additional protections include familial status in housing; age (40 and over) and pregnancy in employment; and tobacco-smoking status in employment.
